

Drew, Bernard A. 100 Most Popular Nonfiction Authors: Biographical Sketches and Biographies. Westport, Connecticut: Libraries Unlimited, 2008. 438p. \$##.## (ISBN: 978-1-59158-487-2)

Published in 2008 by Libraries Unlimited, this hard-cover edition of the one hundred featured nonfiction authors runs a gamut of genres and writing styles that include adventure, autobiography, biography, environment, fiction, food, health, history, humor, investigative reporting, memoir, nature, outdoors, poetry, politics, science, social reportage, spirituality, sports, survival, travel and true crime.

This book is the latest volume in the Popular Author reference series. The authors were selected for this volume by consulting librarians and by picking the most contemporary and popular in that particular genre or style. Some author examples include Maya Angelou, Dave Barry, Truman Capote, Deepak Chopra, Jane Goodall, Frances Mayes, Frank McCourt, and David Sedaris. The purpose of this title is to provide librarians and other users with background information about the authors to aid in selection and collection development to meet reader interest. It might also come in handy for Book Clubs and as a reference for students. An extensive Author/Title Index is included as well as a Genre Index.

For each author entry (examples below are from David Sedaris) Drew includes the category of the genre or style (Autobiography, Humor, Memoir), a Benchmark Title by the author (Me Talk Pretty One Day), the birthplace (Raleigh, NC), date of birth (1957-) and, death if applicable. He then gives a brief description about the author and the author's writing (see the

interesting and unknown facts about Hunter S. Thompson), lists other works by the author and their contributions as Translator, Editor, Film Adaptations, Fiction, Drama, For Juvenile Readers, and Poetry. The author entry concludes with a section for further information; some entries include a photo. Not recommended for libraries with a limited budget or small NF Ref. Coll.
